



SUPPLY CHAIN DISRUPTION.

As the article reads in the September issue of Kitchens & Bathrooms News, supply issues in the kbb industry have been well-documented, with a global surge in demand following the ease of lockdowns, and a shortage of raw materials.

Blum have reported an "above average" growth of 24.7% on the previous year, and although having invested €259million in production worldwide, the company has needed to adjust delivery times to cater for the "rapid" growth in demand.

Blum have instigated a revised ordering procedure on all key product lines across its ranges, for each of its customers. Blum has calculated an Average Monthly Usage which is the amount that can be ordered. Any order going above the figure will be placed into a stock allocation process.

Sales and Marketing director at Blum UK, David Sanders says it offers the fairest way to allocate limited resources. "We took that decision to say every customer is important to us, whether they buy a box of hinges off us every month or wether they buy a million hinges off us. Now that doesn't mean we can give every customer exactly what they want. Nobody is hiding away from that fact that there isn't enough for the demand. But we made the decision every single customer got something and if we've got it all you can have it all. So, it's a fair and equitable distribution of the product".

1. Which customers would benefit from this service?

LDL Specialist Distribution is geared towards clients who require large quantities of Blum Hinge, Lift and Drawer System kits which are packaged to their specific needs. Effectively, what we do is provide bespoke easy fitting kits which are packed as a single SKU for our client's onward customer. All packs contain everything the fitter needs to install the solution from screws, hinges, cover caps and door buffers through to fully assembled drawers and runners.

2. How are you making it easy for customers.

Most of the packs we produce contain up to 8 individual component parts in various quantities, all of which the client would normally have to purchase and receive in large quantities, store, and pick either by job or in box quantities for their onward customer. With LDL Specialist Distribution the client no longer needs to do this as we provide a single packed SKU which is professionally packaged with the clients' bar codes, product codes and descriptions. All they need to do is order a single SKU code from us. Easy.

3. What are the environmental policies in place for larger scale projects?

Environmental decisions are high on the agenda of every project, we work with every client to ensure they have access to the latest Blum innovations and services, improve the quality of the finished SKU but seek out the most eco-friendly products to use in the process.

For example, all bespoke Blum hinge kits we pack for clients are made from a minimum of 30% recycled materials and are 100% recyclable themselves.

Travis Perkins recently set us the task of improving their Hinge, Lift and Drawer Systems and worked with us to reduce the environmental impact of the finished product. All the Blum Lift, Hinge and Drawer Solutions now use bespoke packaging which is 100% recyclable and have a range of pre-assembled drawers for fitters which are packed using fully recyclable products, no plastics or polystyrene in sight. We even use brown paper security tape when sealing drawer boxes.

4. What makes LDL Specialist Distribution Bespoke for the customer?

One of the benefits of Specialist Distribution is the personalised nature of the entire service we offer. We not only provide tailored packing solutions by means of individual kits, but we can also design the packaging around the clients brand to include corporate colours, logos, illustrations, images, bar codes - almost anything you can imagine if required. A debate has been raging between retailers to drop the 'bedrooms' in KBB and re-brand the industry as KBH – kitchens, bathrooms and home.

The topic was started by Tony Robson, owner of Day True, who believes that the term KBB is 'antiquated' and the homes of today are more of a blend of spaces, not strict room types.

He first posed the question to the industry on Linked-in, and then he appeared on the kbbreview Podcast to discuss his thoughts in more detail.

He said on the podcast: "The home has developed. Covid has given everything another nudge in this direction. I would say it has been going on for the past 10 to 15 years and that there seems to be a blurring of spaces in the home. The kitchen is no longer just a kitchen; a bathroom is no longer just a bathroom; a bedroom is no longer just a bedroom."

Although Robson thinks that this change would be beneficial for the industry, the consumer side would not be changed. He explained: "I'm not thinking of this as a consumer focus. I am challenging the industry and asking if the industry should change and maybe the industry should be more forward-thinking."

Robson also highlighted during the podcast that bedrooms are often ignored in the industry and not given the same weight and prestige as bathrooms or kitchens.

Robson believes that having a less divided industry might help companies talk to one another. He explained: "Collaboration is


more important than it ever has been. Bathroom manufacturers should talk to sinks and taps companies, they should be talking to kitchen companies, and they should be talking to bedroom manufacturers."

"There should be more collaboration, and these different parts of the industry should be working together to deliver not just to their customer, which is me as a retailer, but also to our customer and the end-user – the most important person in this whole chain. Having a more cohesive approach by changing one letter to KBH, would be the first step for us to all collaborate more together and for the common good."
